



## **2005 - 2006 Award Winners**

### **The Government Recycler of the Year *Warrior's Path State Park Golf Course***

This course, designed by George Cobb, is one of the most popular courses in the Tennessee State Parks system. It hosts approximately 35,000 rounds of golf per year. The recycling program began in 2003 under the direction of Mark Houser. The primary commodities recycled are plastic bottles and cardboard, although a small amount of aluminum is collected and donated to a local church or non-profit organization. In 2005, 4,000 pounds of cardboard and 2,500 pounds of plastics were recycled. The Tri-Cities area was recently ranked by Golf Digest as the second best golfing area in the country allowing Warrior's Path State Park Golf Course to demonstrate Tennessee's commitment to conservation to local residents and visitors alike.
